Brief Bio

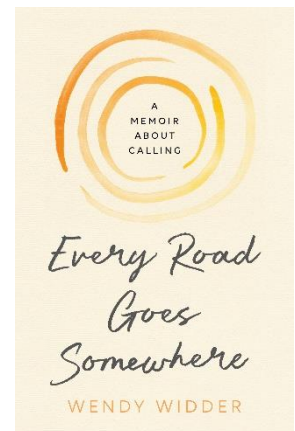
